Ninth Month

Have you ever wondered why September October, November and December are named after numbers in Latin? It is because they were never changed to the names of the various Caesar's.

January-Janus is the Roman god of gates and doorways, depicted with two faces looking in opposite directions. His festival month is January.

February-Februa is the Roman festival of purification

March-March was the original beginning of the year and the time for the resumption of war. Mars is the Roman god of war. He is identified with the Greek god Ares.

April-Greek Aphro, short for Aphrodite. Aphrodite is the Greek goddess of love and beauty. She is identified with the Roman goddess Venus.

May-Maia (meaning “the great one”) is the Italic goddess of spring, the daughter of Faunus, and wife of Vulcan.

June-Juno is the principle goddess of the Roman Pantheon. She is the goddess of marriage and the well-being of women. She is the wife and sister of Jupiter. She is identified with the Greek goddess Hera.

July-Julius Caesar reformed the Roman calendar (hence the Julian calendar) in 46 BC. In the process, he renamed this month after himself.

August-Latin sextilis mensis “sixth month”-Augustus Caesar clarified and completed the calendar reform of Julius Caesar. In the process, he also renamed this month after himself.

September-Latin September mensis “seventh month”

October-Latin October mensis “eighth month”

November-Latin Novembris mensis “ninth month”

December-Latin December “tenth month”

You will notice a few things in this. First of all that March was originally the 1st month of the year. This is because most of the time in March we have the Passover which comes in the first month. Exodus 12:2 states this month when Passover comes is the first month.

You will also notice that the 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th months have retained their original names only we have them in Latin today. This week we have begun the 9th month, November, but using the barley to begin the year and the moon to begin the months the 9th month will begin at the end of this coming week. So December is the 10th month and not the 12th month as our current calendars say it is and the end of the year.

This then leads back to January which is the month of Janus, the god that looks forward and backward. January will be the 11th month.

As with many of our teachings, you can only understand the world today if you understand the history that has brought us to the current situation we now find ourselves in.

In our teaching on the Great Enlightenment of Mankind, we do the very same thing going right back to Noah’s wife, Ham, Cush and Nimrod to show you how those very same systems of worship then, are in force today and how it has now morphed in the world Governments in play today. This is why it is so important to understand ancient history.

September through to December each year preserve in their very names the system that Yehovah had in place. Each month was named in the order it came starting with the Aviv.

The Tomb Stones of Zoar

This year while I was in Israel showing my Daughter around the country and Jerusalem and helping her to understand my love of this land, I had another opportunity to meet with Nehemia Gordon and this time to sit down and explain the Sabbatical and Jubilee years once again to him. I told my daughter to go shopping while I spent the morning talking to Nehemia. I expected the conversation to last only about 3 hours and I would be back shortly after lunch. This meeting turned into an all-day event that was quite simply just awesome.

We have been featuring the teachings of Nehemia which I encourage you all to take part in on our sidebar of his podcasts.

I first met Nehemia in the winter of 2004-2005 when he was in Lansing Michigan doing to conference with Michael Rood. I also met Michael at this conference. they were talking about the crescent moon to begin the month which for me at this time was earth-shattering.

I studied this subject the rest of that winter and had compiled my evidence until Passover came and I had proven that we are indeed to keep the Sighted moon to begin the month. You can read one of the very first articles I had written which was about this very subject.

Conjunction or

Sighted, Which? At the time I was not planning on having my own website. I was just doing my own research after hearing what Nehemia and Michael had presented.



That winter of 2005 Nehemia announced that the barley was ripe a full 30 days before we at the United Church of God were going to keep the Passover. I was very upset as I had planned to keep both calendars at the same time and no one would notice what I was doing. Not my Church family and not my own family. I was and still am married to an unconverted mate. So I fired off a very nasty email to Nehemia. I regret this now. I was angry not at him the messenger but at myself, because I was being forced to make a decision that I was trying to hide from.

But now this meant that Passover would be in March for the sighted moon followers and in April for the Hebrew Calendar or Conjunction Moon followers. My Church, The United Church of God, which was one of the many that came out of the World Wide Church of God, kept the conjunction moon. But I had just proven that we should be keeping the Sighted moon or crescent moon and going by the barley as I share with you in that article [Conjunction or Sighted Which?](#)

So I resolved it in my mind that I would keep both calendars this year and see what happens. Two Passovers. Two Feasts of Unleavened Bread, Two Shavuot, Two Trumpets. Two Atonements, and two Feast of Tabernacles and two 8th Day Feasts. And this is what I did in 2005. But I only kept one Day of Atonement as by this point I was 100% sure we were to keep the Sighted moon to count to the Holy Days from.

I have shared this story many times now.

It was at the Feast of Passover while I kept it for the first time according to the Crescent moon and the barley being Aviv that Yehovah revealed to me the timing of the Sabbatical and Jubilee years and the curses for not keeping them. I came across the writings of Qadesh La Yahweh Press which had a book titled [The Sabbath and Jubilee Cycle](#).

Over the next few years, as I worked on this new found information proving it and searching it and researching it, that I did the charts that are available from our website. The [Millennial Charts](#) and the Sabbatical and Jubilee charts all of them starting with the creation of Adam.

In 2008, I again went to Israel and asked Nehemia if we could meet. He agreed and I thought we had a 15-minute meeting and it turned into over 2 hours long as we sat there just to the left of the Zion Gate discussing the Sabbatical and Jubilee year with crowds of people walking by. At this time I only had 12 to base my proof upon. Nehemia had a great deal of research but could not get any consistent dates to match each other. As a result, he concluded that it was not possible to know. But he was interested to hear what I had found.

So I left him with a large box of my research and the books that I had printed off for him. One being that From Qadesh La Yahweh Press about The Sabbatical and Jubilee Cycles, and the other was the manuscript of what would later become The Prophecies of Abraham and the charts of all the Sabbatical and Jubilee years throughout history.

I would meet Nehemia each year in Jerusalem and renew our friendship but we never got time to discuss the Sabbatical and Jubilee years specifically.

I made enough noise amongst the Messianic groups over the next few years that Michael Rood and Nehemia did a show on the subject in which they said no one could know the year. I wrote them both after this and I also met with Michael Rood in Jerusalem in 2010 at Shavuot and talked about this then.

In 2013 we presented all of our findings over each of the 8 days of Sukkot. These teachings were videoed and are available to anyone at our YouTube site and at our new [Brighteon](#) site. It was while I was speaking that one of those in the audience asked me about the Tombstone of Zoar. they had two dates which were recorded from the destruction of the Temple and used the Sabbatical years also as a reference. So in front of the entire group we checked the dates to see if they would, in fact, match our charts. A very great risk to do publicly. But we did and sure enough I now had two more new dates to add to our collection.

Later on, in the following years leading up to 2016, I would hear one of Nehemia's podcasts about the Tomb Stones of Zoar. I had not heard of them but the two presented to me in 2013 were part of this collection. That began me on this search to find as many of them as possible. But I was restrained, as many of the articles were written in Hebrew and were scholarly research papers in archives at universities. We collected many of them and I only had them translated for me this past winter of 2018.

Then this year, 2018, year Nehemia did a podcast and an interview with Michael Rood on the Sabbatical Years and how no one could know them. I wrote him and told him otherwise and he added a link to my research which now had 45 Sabbatical and Jubilee years documented. I then asked him for

a date when we could discuss this subject specifically. He responded and said at Sukkot 2018. So this is the history leading up to our meeting this past Sukkot in Israel.

I had copied all our information from the News Letter that we published about all of the dates we had and the sources to verify each date. I had a copy for Nehemia and one for myself. We agreed to focus on just the tombstones.

We met in a coffee shop in German Colony and it was not long into our talk that our papers became messed up on that small table as we went back and forth. Nehemia was very interested in the Tombstones. I had more than he was aware of but the way I logged them was chronologically and Nehemia needed them done according to the Naveh list. Naveh is the archeologist who has specialized in these tombstones. So I agreed to go back home and make a list that had all of Joseph Naveh's Tombstone on them.

So here is the chart I have made for Nehemia just covering the Tomb Stone I have collected. I use my numbering system so that they can be found in [my Proofs at sightedmoon.com](#). I then have Joseph Naveh's numbering of each Tomb Stone and this is the same way Nehemia has them recorded.

I then marked the day of the death as recorded and the day of the week if it is provided. This is important as it shows us that they were using the barley to begin the year and the crescent moon to begin the month. If you use the Hebrew calculated conjunction calendar then you are not able to find or match any of these dates.

You also need to know the month so I have listed them here as well. When you understand that the religious year began with Aviv and the Civil year began with Tishri it helps a great deal in understanding what they have done with the Tomb Stone dating. They had moved the start of the year for the Shemitah from Aviv to Tishri 6 months before. So this understanding makes it possible to locate when the Shemitah is if they say it is the 8th or 11th month for example. They, having started the Shemitah at Tishri which is the 7th-month means they were already counting that year as a Shemitah when in fact it did not start until Aviv.

The same goes for the end of the Shemitah cycle. They would have ended the year at Tishri and declared the 8th month in the first year of the next cycle when in fact it was still part of the Shemitah which would only end at Aviv.

Then I have the years since the destruction of the Temple. What I did here was to add the year the Temple was destroyed to the year they gave on the Tomb Stone to get this year in this column. That way I can easily check it in my charts.

After that I recorded what the tombstone has written on it and then how to understand if it fits our chronology or not.

Out of the 30 Tombstones of Zoar we have only 7 that we cannot use and the other 23 all match our chronology of the Sabbatical and Jubilee years although some need to be explained as I have above.

Why is any of this and all of this important?

All of the Tombstones have been found outside the land of Israel. These Tombstones are from Zoar with the exception of one. Zoar is part of the land of Moab and today is to be found in the Nation of Jordan. Israel was not to possess the land of Moab.

Deut 2:9 “And we turned and went in the direction of the wilderness of Moab. And the Lord said to me, Do not harass Moab or contend with them in battle, for I will not give you any of their land for a possession, because I have given Ar to the people of Lot for a possession.”

The other Tomb Stone that is found was from Baalbek was in the year 838 C.E. and is from the area north of Damascus which at this time was not controlled by the nation Israel. Although it was in the area promised to Israel. So you can contend this one.

Moses ben Maimon, commonly known as Maimonides, and also referred to by the acronym Rambam lived in Spain and Egypt outside the land of Israel and he was accurately counting the Shemita cycles and as noted above claimed that the year 1107 was the first year in the Shemita cycle.

Deut 15:1 “At the end of every seven years you shall grant a release. And this is the manner of the release: every creditor shall release what he has lent to his neighbor. He shall not exact it of his neighbor, his brother, because the Lord’s release has been proclaimed.

So if this was just for when they are in the land why are they concerned about knowing when the Shemita is now? So they can forgive debts and take care of the widows in the 3rd and 6th year and so they won't plant or harvest in the land they are in.
