James Relf was a man I met in Israel on one of the tours I cohosted with Avi Ben Mordechai. James lived not far from me and when my web site was highjacked and I was being extorted to get it back, James came to my rescue and stealthily got the site back up and running before any of you knew it was off line. That was in 2013. He has been working with me since then and has become a trusted friend and sounding board for the things I have come to understand.

In 2005 James went to Australia to speak at a conference and do some work for Bradley Hay a close friend of his. At this conference, he by accident met Bishop Telesphore Ntashimikiro and the man who would become the President of Burundi Pierre Nkurunziza. Telesphore and James would keep writing to each other over the years.

In January of 2015, James wanted to send to Telesphore my books and DVD's. I was not too sure about doing this as the man was a Bishop for some Christian group. My prejudice almost prevented the miracle that was to happen from happening. But James insisted and even said he would pay for the shipping cost, which was over \$300 to send the books and DVD's to Africa.

We would later get a picture of Telesphore in his Bishops attire teaching about the books to the many churches he was shepherding.





Telesphore asked us to come and teach these truths to him and all his pastors in 2015. At the same time, we had the opportunity to go to the Philippines and teach there for sukkot. Telesphore advised us the cost to host in Burundi would be about \$36,000 US. The cost for us to take a camera man and spend three weeks in the Philippines was going to be about \$15,000. There was no way we could do both and we could not even afford to go to the Philippines let alone Burundi. So Burundi was on their own.

I went to the Philippines in 2015 and then in 2016 James and Telesphore found a way for James to go there without it costing us a fortune. James was to go to Burundi for two weeks before Sukkot and then meet with me in Israel for Sukkot. James got sick while in Burundi and was sick for most of the time in Israel. We determined it was due to the Malaria pills he had to take in order not to get Malaria.

I had wanted James to determine if this Bishop was for real or faking us out in order to get funding from us. James already knew Telesphore and was going to confirm what he knew to be the facts. This trip of James was so successful that in 2017 it was decided to send James again for an entire month. I could not afford to go. James spent the month traveling to many of the churches and teaching them the Sabbath and Holy Days. He was very excited about the growth and the many open doors shown to him. James even met with the Vice President and explained our message to him. The Vice President was genuinely interested.

At the end of this trip, the Vice President wanted to meet James and this time me also and said we would then meet with the President. And He arranged for this to take place on Sept. 2 weekend. So James came home for those three weeks in between and we prepared to go again to Burundi. This meant more Malaria pills and for me to get my Yellow Fever shot and have all my medical documentation ready to present at customs when I got to Burundi.

We also received a letter from the Vice President;

The date was set for Sept 1 and Sept 2 that we would be speaking with the Vice President and the President. James booked the tickets with Ethiopian Airlines. It was a 13-hour flight from Toronto Canada to Addis Ababa, Ethiopia with a 4-1/2 hour layover and then a 2-1/2 hour flight to Bujumbura Burundi.

Our return flight was from Bujumbura to Goma, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, a 1/2 hour flight with a one-hour layover while we pick up passengers. Then a 2 1/2 hour flight from Goma to Addis Ababa Ethiopia with a 4-hour wait there. And what a crush of people trying to get through the security there all to catch flights leaving at the same time. It was pandemonium. From Addi Ababa, we then flew to Dublin Ireland, an 8-hour flight with one hour waiting on board the plane before we would then fly the final 7-1/2 hour flight back to Toronto. Then we had a 1-hour wait for our luggage and 2 1/2 hour drive home after landing. In all, we were up Monday and then flying for a total of about 32 hours before we got home on Tuesday.

It is not all glamour doing this work for Yehovah. Much of the time it is spent alone in airports traveling and in lineups to board planes.

Wednesday, August 30, 2017

Upon arrival in Bujumbura, the Vice President sent his senior assistant Amahorroh and Telesphore and Pastor Daimon, to escort us through customs via a VIP door, by passing all the crowds. After a long and tiring trip to Burundi, I was beginning to feel very welcomed and wanted. At the same time, my nose had begun to run for some unknown reason and my eczema was flaring up all over my face due to the stress of traveling and of the meetings we were about to have. And the unknown. We did not know what the schedule was.

Telesphore was going to let us rest in our rooms and I told him we could rest when we got back to Canada. We only had a few days and we had better make the most of the time we had. Telesphore then went and got about 10 of his pastors to come and meet with James and I at the hotel that Wednesday afternoon. I ended up giving them a teaching on the Sabbatical and Jubilee cycles. I would find out later some of these same pastors were sitting on the fence about the Sabbath and Holy Days.

The pastors all had to leave before sunset. I would soon find out why. The electricity for the town of Bujumbura is shut off for the night about 7 PM. It is then turned on for about an hour in the morning at about 8 AM. Then turned off for the day and back on about 6-8 PM but you never know for how long in the evenings it is on. After that, some places fire up diesel powered generators or small electric ones. I quickly learned to power up my phone and battery lamp every chance I had. I took many a shower and shave by lamp light. We ate chicken and chips and a salad for supper.

We ate chicken and chips and a salad for supper. We had this almost every night because it did not have pork in it. We had to eat before sunset to avoid the mosquitoes that come out after dusk. And we wanted to avoid the possibility of being bitten and contracting malaria. I kept my windows closed at night and I searched and killed any mosquitoes that were inside my netting that enveloped the bed. With no electricity, the air conditioners did not work. It did not work when the hydro was on either. So I slept in my long johns with a turtle neck sweater and socks on my feet inside my mosquito netting each night with no window open and no air conditioner. I did get very warm at night. Stifling at times., but I was determined not to get bitten.



Then in the morning, I would go to the washroom with my battery lamp and as I sat there, each and every morning I would hear that annoying buzz around my head and then catch a glimpse of one of two mosquitos in the washroom. This would happen each and every morning. I did manage to kill one but by the end of our stay, two more had moved in. And they would always

fly up from behind me as I sat there. I made it a habit to always have my hands rubbing my thighs as I sat each morning. You may laugh now, but at the time, I was very concerned about contracting one of the many diseases that mosquitos host.



Thursday, August 31, 2017

Having now traveled from Toronto to Bujumbura and gotten very little sleep on the plane since Tuesday when we left and then again not sleeping very much due to the heat at night both James and I were picked up by Telesphore in a rented car with a driver and Pastor Daimon. We were off to see the Prime Minister at his home in the country.

Because of the fact they have no electricity in Bujumbura, everything is cooked on coals. Morning and evening. In the country side, the people burn the trees to turn them into coal branches which are then taken by bicycle and brought into the city each day and sold. Although Bujumbura is surrounded by mountains I could not see them for the constant haze that is over the city. My eyes burned each day and there was this taste at the back of your throat that is always there and tastes bitter. James had warned me but I thought he exaggerated things. He did not.

As we climbed up into the mountains I expected the air to clear. It did not as we were in the area where they burnt the trees to make the charcoal. The road was straight for about 100 yards if that, then it turned left or right and then up or down and you could never see that far ahead. Our driver thought he was an Indi 500 racer and we raced through the mountains around bends and passing people, bicycles, and lorries at break neck speeds. Both James and I had to hold the handle on the roof to keep from falling over into each other. When they pass here they blow the horn to let you know they are passing and once they get the front of the vehicle past the other they then cut you off. It did not matter if other cars were coming or people were on the road or bicycles. It was a white knuckle ride. And I travel the 400 highways in Toronto each day. They are between 6 and 20 lanes wide and jammed with cars, but this ride out does the 400 Hwys.

On the side of the road is ditch about 2-4 feet deep to take away the rain water. Going around two of the hundreds of bends were two lorries that had cut the corner too sharp and fallen into the ditch and then flipped over. The warning system they use to let drivers know there is an accident ahead is to throw small tree branches on the road leading up to the accident.

The people all walk on the side of the road while the cars go flying past. They are all HIV thin or Famine thin. The women all dressed in colorful dresses and the men in trousers. Those on bikes are either being helped to push the loaded bike up the mountain or they are racing down the mountain at break neck speeds with them fully loaded. Everything is transported on their heads or on bicycles. The ditches are cleaned and rebuilt by everyone in the area. Men women and children. You can see one of the work crews in this picture.



Here is a picture of the road alongside one of the many villages we raced through. I am not being critical of the way of life they are living.... No, I am showing you just how poor this nation is and what they have to do to survive.



We would often see bicycles hitching a ride on the back of a lorry going up the mountains. Sometimes we saw as many as 6 across the back all holding on until they got to their destination.



We drove for a couple of hours and then arrived at the Vice Presidents home.

There were strategically placed Army personnel on trucks with Machine Guns. We drove down a laneway and then after we were granted permission to enter we were all searched and our bags opened to inspection.

I had expected to have a 20-minute meeting with Vice President Gaston Sindimwo. Instead, we talked for about 3 hours before we departed.

He was genuinely interested to know about the Jubilee cycles and Daniel 9 and what was coming. When we began to talk about the UN where he told us that the UN had cut off all their funding in retaliation for the failed coup in 2015. This coup in 2015 was sponsored by the UN in an effort to remove President Pierre Nkurunziza who had just won 98% of the popular vote for a third term in office.

The UN wanted him out of office because he would not submit to the demands of the UN charter which is now called the Paris Treaty on the Environment. The same one President Trump has vowed to get out of, which President Obama signed into law immediately after Trump won the elections in November 2016. In this charter, the UN pushes for human right to help save the environment. But the only human right they are pushing for is the right of the LGBTQ. Burundi is one husband and one wife lifestyle. They do not tolerate any of this LGBT stuff. And it is because of this intolerance for the PRIDE agenda that Burundi is being penalized today by the UN and her member nations.

The UN is supposed to be doing, that is collecting the money from the rich nations and giving it to the poor ones to develop their infrastructure to lower the pollution that they generate like Burundi does from burning charcoal. In Canada, we pay a carbon tax on all our energy we consume. That tax then goes to the UN and it is to go to help these poor nations. But the carbon tax is still collected but it does not go to the poor nations. A small portion might, but here in Burundi, the poorest nation on earth, they get nothing because they do not accept LGBTQ in their nation.

The UN is such a whore!!!! And I can see it so plainly now. It is described in Revelation 13, 17, and 18. The UN, EU Germany combination is this great whore spoken of in your bible and here in Burundi, we can see her at work promoting her evil propaganda.

James and I and Telesphore all thought this meeting went very well. Exceptionally well.

After this, I was under the impression we were going to meet the President who was further up country. Two weeks before we were to arrive here, we were asked if we could change everything and come on Sept 8 and 9th. We could not change our flights and work schedules at this late date. The President had meetings with his entire cabinet this weekend and he was about to bless the nation which I did not realize.

When we arrived I could see we had just come to a very big event, but I did not know what it was at this time. We were greeted by the assistant to the Prime Minister and ushered to the front row of the dignitary's section. Beside me was the Cardinal from the Catholic Church. And he had the most VIP seat. James Telesphore and I sat beside him. Just a few feet away from him was where the President would sit. As soon as we sat down the video cameras and news cameras began to take pictures of us before during and after the ceremonies. I did not know what was going on until Telesphore told me.

The President twice a year, Sept and December, blesses the nation of Burundi. His entire cabinet comes out and all the dignitaries of whom we were now part of. But the thing that impressed me the most was not that some Priest or Pastor does all the talking and then the President says a few words. No, here the President conducts the whole service.

This man that I had considered a tyrant, which the media in the west had told me he was; this man who would not allow his nation to turn into another LGBT nation; this President who was leading the prayer service and reading from the Bible; this leader who let 450 Million be withheld from his annual budget in order to stand up for the moral rights of his people; this President who was voted in by 98% of the population was teaching the over 5000 people in attendance about obeying God so they could be blessed by God.

As I listened and watched, my views of this "Tyrant" totally changed and I realized I had been hoodwinked by the media and the UN once again. Let me now share with you a bunch of short videos from this day.

Here is a series of short videos about 30 seconds to 5 minutes long each. They will give you the flavor of the day as the President blessed the people and the Burundi Drums which are world famous. This was quite the day.

We did not get to meet the President as I thought we were supposed to. But I do understand. After this day the President was with the Prime Minister and saw the books we had left him. The President took the books so he could read them. We received a call asking if we had any more books to give to the Prime Minister which we did and we would see him again on Monday before we left.

The following picture was at the end of the Presidential Blessing as we were leaving. This is part of the 5000, as far as you can see, even climbing up in the church windows and trees to get a better view. They stood there shoulder to shoulder for about 3 hours and never moved. It was something to behold. I do hope you are able to get the feeling of the day from the many videos I have posted here.



After this, we then drove back in the dark over those mountainous roads. Again with people crossing them and our driving going as if in the Daytona 500.

Friday, September 1, 2017

This is Edmond my interpreter and we are speaking in front of about 350 people and it is Friday morning. We can't get 20 people to come out on the Sabbath in North America but here on a week day, we have 350 people who want to learn and understand. James and I were to

split the speaking this day and on Sabbath. But James came down with something and just before the meeting asked me to take over. I started with his notes and then began to go off the cuff.



We started to explain the Holy Days one at a time and I kept asking them questions. As they gave me the Christian answers we then would go into the scriptures and get the truth. The one

that amazed many of them was to find out the reason they kept Sunday was found in Lev 23. The wave sheaf or Ascension Sunday and Pentecost Sunday. We then showed them how the scriptures teach them Yehshua was in the grave 3 days and 3 nights. That He did not die on Good Friday. This was very exciting to see them learn this and so many light bulbs went off in their heads.

Afterwards, one lady sitting in the dignitary section stood up to say just how exciting it was for her to learn these things and how she would like to learn more.

Afterwards, Telesphore told me she was the daughter of the founder of Burundi whom the Belgium Gov had killed. His name was Tutsi Prince Louis Rwagasore and she was in charge of one of the Government agencies. I would have liked to have had more time to talk to her.

We stopped for lunch and James had to go back to the Hotel because he was getting worse. I had planned to finish the teaching James had in the afternoon. We had only covered the Spring Feasts and I wanted to get the fall ones done this day as well.

As I Set up for the afternoon session, Telesphore came to me and asked if we could not have an afternoon teaching. He said it was the Preparation day and many of the brethren had to go home and prepare for the Sabbath. They did not have fridges and stoves or dependable electricity. So they actually had to prepare for the Sabbath. Something I had not considered. I usually just go to the fridge and get left overs or make a sandwich. And suddenly I was humbled beyond words by the actions of these people. They are seriously trying to obey.

So we canceled the afternoon session so they could prepare for the Sabbath before sunset. We stopped by a sandwich place and got some things for lunch tomorrow.

Let me say right here that although this report is speaking of the people of Burundi in glowing terms and affection, I am by no mean unaware of the history of this place and the many horrors that took place here. You can read about them in this article and or this one. And this is the most recent one I have found on Burundi from the UN.

Saturday, Sept 2, 2017

Just before we were to leave to go back to the hall, we get a phone call from Telesphore. There has been a slight change in the day's events. We would not be able to host from the same air-conditioned hall where I taught the day before. There was not enough room for all the people coming. The hall held about 500. So they had moved it outside. This meant I would not be able to use the charts I had posted on the walls. Nor could I use the projector I had planned to use. Now I was scrambling to figure out how to teach them through an interpreter with no charts or drawings.

When we arrived there were about 1000 people outside sitting in the hot sun trying to find shade anywhere they could. they had encircled the courtyard and had speakers set up and many groups singing and dancing before I even got up to speak. I was just stupefied. I had

never had that big a crowd to speak to in any meeting in North America. Even the Philippines paled in comparison.

Just look at the videos I have posted here of the crowds and the dancing and singing. There are many videos in this series that will load one after another. But when you get to the Burundi Sabbath #7 I want you to look at the little boy in the yellow pull over. This group at the end of the day wanted a picture with me. SO I told them to gather around. Then, I saw the little boy walking by and he was crying. So I put my arms to him to see if he would let me pick him up. He did so the people started to take pictures as I did this. And the group was gathering around me. I grabbed the little boy and sat him on my knee as I knelt with one knee down and one up. After I placed the little boy on my knee and as the pictures were being snapped, I then placed my two hands on the boy's thighs to steady him from falling off my knee. Again the pictures are going all the time. It was only then when I grabbed his thighs did I realize why he was crying. He had wet his pants and was soaking wet and I had both my hands right on it and kept thinking to keep smiling, but could hardly wait to get his little soaking but off my knee. LOL. Yes, I had to go wash my hands. That was a special moment. LOL.

Sunday Sept 3, 2017

James is still sick and today Telesphore takes me to two churches to preach to them. They are still sitting on the fence about the Sabbath.

The one thing I kept repeating over and over at all these groups was this. The sign of insanity is to keep doing the same thing over and over and to then expect a different result each time. They keep Sunday and pray and sing to Jesus and yet they are the poorest nation on earth.

We read the blessings to each group. Not one person was able to count any blessings that they had received. When we then read Lev 26 and I asked them to count the curses they all said they had all the curses mentioned. I would then again say to them The sign of Insanity. We did this over and over.

Then I went on to explain the mark of Satan, 666 and how it was Sunday and all the other holidays not found in Lev 23. I then showed them the mark of Yehovah which is the Sabbath and the Holy Days.

After this I showed them how Ascension Sunday and Pentecost Sunday, the two reason they keep Sunday as the sabbath, are found in Lev 23 and if they are found there then why are they not keeping the other Holy Days?

Before I share the report from Telesphore about his take on this week's events let me just share with you about our last day in Burundi and our meeting with the Vice President. We met him in his home in Bujumbura and I began to explain to him about the soil and how they needed to feed the worms in order to get the worm poop to make the food grow better. I then went out back to his farm and showed him the cow manure and then the composting grass he had. He may have thought I was crazy but he did understand about the benefits of the worms.



We presented the Vice President with another set of books because the President had taken the first set we gave to him.

Once we got the airport James was almost 100% better. We talked about this and wondered why he got sick during the time he was here and not before and not now as we left. It was very curious.

I am out of time to write more about this past weekend. If I have not already said so let me now say it. I want to thank all of those who stepped up to support our efforts to get to Burundi and to help Telesphore share this message. You too will reap the reward that awaits us for doing this work in these last days. I do thank you for your letter and financial support. But we are not yet done. We continue to support Aike in the Philippines and we are now going to support Telesphore in Burundi.

You will see some pictures below of the clinic Telesphore looks after. He also has an orphanage. The two nurses have not been paid for the past three months and yet they continue to do their work treating people with HIV and malaria and Dengue Fever as well as Cholera.



The next picture is the reception area just inside the front door.




This is the Doctors office or examining room. The Doctor comes by twice a week to check on the patients.



To help combat HIV they dispense free condoms to whoever wants one. Many of the children here never know who the father is. Some of the brethren grew up this way and they are very zealous to end this vicious cycle.

TEACHING LED BY JOSEPH DUMOND AND JAMES RELF

Day 1 : 6 Sept. arrival of Joseph and James with Ethiopian Airlines and taken down to the downtown hotel in Bujumbura.

Meeting : Meeting with few church leaders at the hotel who have some questions. Joseph briefed them about what they came to teach under the request of the Bishops and the Prime Vice President he accepted the invitation to visit for a teaching as many were thirsty for the teaching.

Day 2 : 7 September : Joseph and James were taken by Bishop Telesphore to meet with the Prime Vice-President outside of the capital city, after long discussion with the Prime Vice -President, he asked Joseph to attend the crusade of thanksgiving upcountry organized by the President of the Republic of Burundi himself. The President was prepared to meet Joe and hear Joseph and James, unfortunately the time was too short. A package of Books written by Joseph Dumond have been given to the President and his Prime Vice-President of the Burundi Republic. Both were really enjoyed to the message from the books after reading some chapters.

During the crusade Joseph Dumond was so much happy to see the President of the Republic of Burundi worshipping our Yehovah and blessing the people of Burundi and the Nation.

Day 3. 8 Sept. A training made of Bishops, church leaders, government officials and many from different denominations were present to hear the message from Joseph in a conference hall. Many choirs and groups of praise and worship made of good symphony like that of heavenly Seraphs. When Joseph started to teach those gathered in the hall, everybody in the room was listening carefully the teaching especially understanding the Sabbath, Sabbatical year and Jubilee year and cycles, the observation of the true Sabbath of Yahweh according to the Hebrew translation, the reading of the Torah and teaching that the New Testament did not come to remove the Torah but to fulfill what was said in the Torah, keeping the 7 Feasts of Yahweh ect....in conclusion he said: all these are our source of curses and blessing from Yahweh as mentioned in the Book of Leviticus.
