Call for action to avoid looming food crisis

AFP) – Soaring global food prices are a wake-up call to action to avoid a new food crisis that would pitch millions more of the world's poor into hunger, US researchers said Thursday.

Derek Headey, IFPRI research fellow and report co-author, said that many of the factors that caused the 2008 crisis also caused the 1974 commodity crisis “and some of these factors are again playing out in 2010.”

The study was published amid renewed volatility in and concern about food prices. Since June, the price of wheat has increased by 60 percent and maize by 50 percent, IFPRI noted.

It came a day after the United Nations' Food and Agriculture Organization predicted global cereal production would drop 2.0 percent, reversing an earlier estimate of a 1.2 percent rise, driving up food prices.

The FAO said Wednesday the global import food bill was approaching the one-trillion-dollar mark, and if it exceeded that mark, prices would be back to the record peaks set in 2008.

Also in the news this week was Haiti.

The Cholera outbreak is getting worse and worse each day. Addressing a U.N. news conference by video link from Haiti, Fisher said experts from the World Health Organization were now revising their estimate that the diarrheal disease, spread by poor sanitation, would cause 200,000 cases within six months. And thousands are going to die. Again I share this with you because we are in the third curse of Lev 26 and the Sabbatical cycles which deals with Pestilence and earthquakes and famines.

Y'shua haMashiach is Hebrew for Jesus the Messiah, and the Hebrew word Shalom means much more than peace, hello or goodbye. In essence it means: Completeness, wholeness, health, peace, welfare, safety soundness, tranquility, prosperity, perfectness, fullness, rest, harmony, the absence of agitation or discord. This is the highest form of greeting somebody, and with this we greet you.

Before we get to this book about our Fathers Name, I also received the following note from Stephen Houston who captures what many of you need to keep in mind before you send off some hate mail to those you call brethren.

Anyone who speaks lashon hara – afflictions come upon him. [Arachin 15b] Lashon Hareia speaking evil

A lashon hara speaker changes the order of letters. By causing a falling out between friends, he turns לָשׁוֹן – “tongue” into שׁוֹלָן – “fall”.

By ruining a precious vessel – “the lips of knowledge are a precious vessel” [Proverbs 20:15] – he turns כֶּסֶף “precious” into פֶּסֶם – “impurity”.

Measure for measure, מִסֵּד – oneg -“delight” will turn into מִסֵּד – nogah – “affliction” – and afflictions will come upon him.

Lashon hara (or Loshon hora) (Hebrew לָשׁוֹן הָרָע; “evil language/tongue”) is the prohibition in Hebrew Law of telling gossip. Lashon hara differs from defamation in that its focus is on the use of true speech for a wrongful purpose, rather than falsehood and harm arising. By contrast, Motzi Shem Ra (“spreading a bad name”) consists of untrue remarks, and is akin to slander or defamation.

acronym of “motzi shem ra

Speech is considered to be lashon hara if it says something negative about a person or party, is not previously known to the public, is not seriously intended to correct or improve a negative situation, and most importantly, is true. Statements that fit this description are considered to be lashon hara, regardless of the method of communication that is used, whether it is through face-to-face conversation, a written letter, telephone, or email.

According to the majority of Torah scholars, lashon hara is considered to be a most serious sin. Therefore, they proclaim, how much more serious is such a statement that is false?

Lashon” is translated as “language” or “tongue”. The phrase is generally translated as “evil speech”. It is true that the concept of lashon hara is regarding true and correct statements. Lies and falsehoods and exaggerated information fall into a worse category called Hotzaat Diba, or ??????????

????????????? Dibatam their reports derogatory/slandorous or defamatory speech which is, in fact, worse than lashon hara in many ways.

This week I want to talk about our Fathers Name which is spoken of in the Prayer to Our Father by Keith Johnson and Nehemiah Gordon. I have wanted to share this for some time now.

I am taken to task about once a week by someone like those emails I shared with you. When I learned God had a name I was awed by that and once I knew it I began to use the name of Yahweh in my writings and speaking. I was so proud to be able to say my Father’s name and to be able to say it out loud. I was not allowed to do this when I attended the Churches of God. Then I began to receive many emails about how the Fathers name was not Yahweh but one of the many other version that are now being used by different Messianic and Hebrew roots groups. But it was not that they were trying to help me understand but many of them were condemning me for not using the version that they had come up with and Brethren some of them were just weird. I determine to stay with what I understood even if it was wrong because no one could prove it. Most of these people had learned just enough Hebrew to be dangerous to all those they met with misinterpretations of key words.

In the winter of 2010 Nehemiah Gordon was speaking at a Baptist church in London Ontario and I just had to go and say hello. After all London was just 2 ½ hours away and it was Feb and winter and cold. But Nehemiah was speaking with a black Methodist Minister named Keith Johnson and I just had to see what this was all about.
