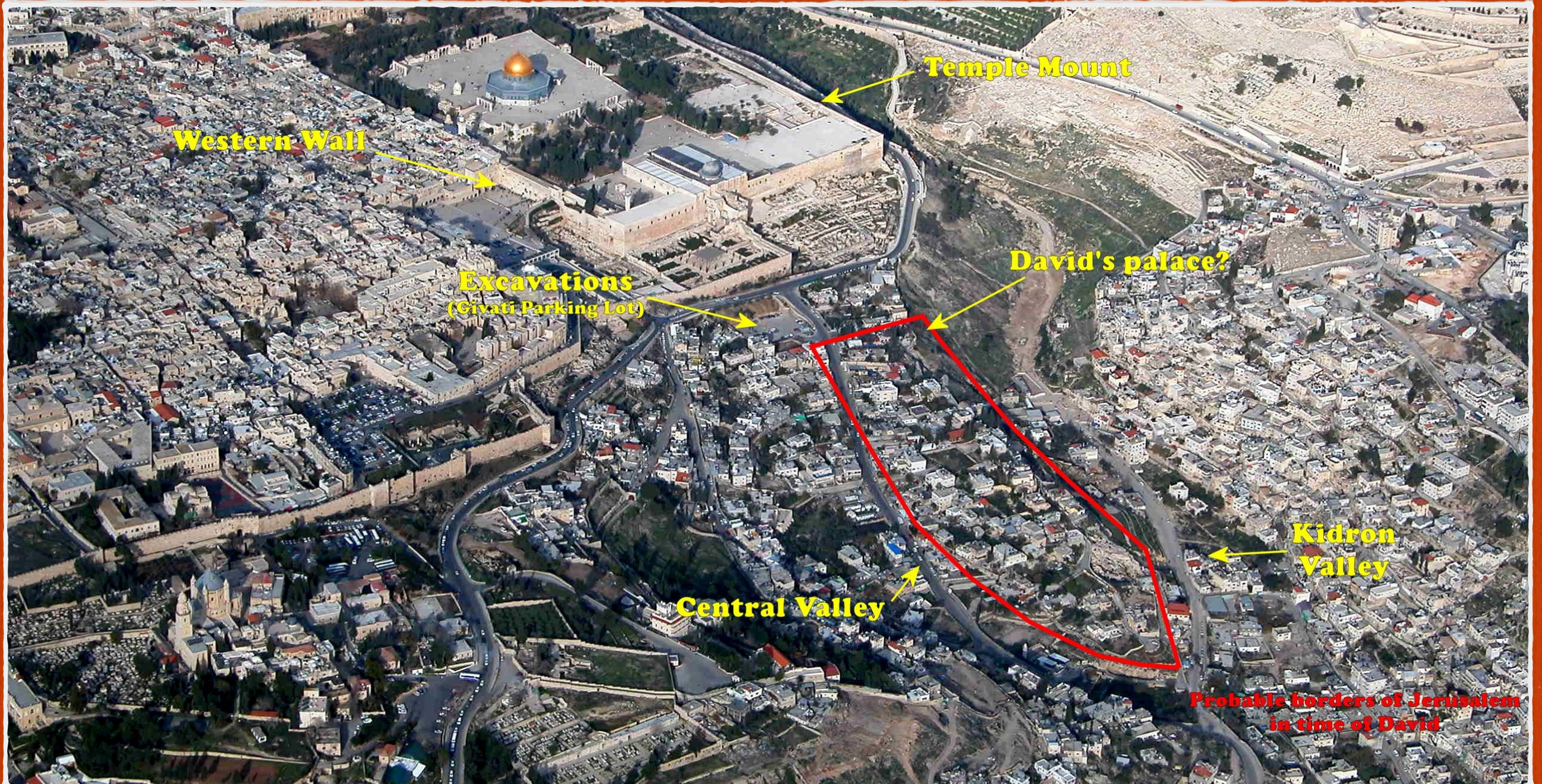

Jeremiah 37:3 and 38:1 Clay Bulla's and Hezekiah's Tunnel. 2 Chronicles 32:30



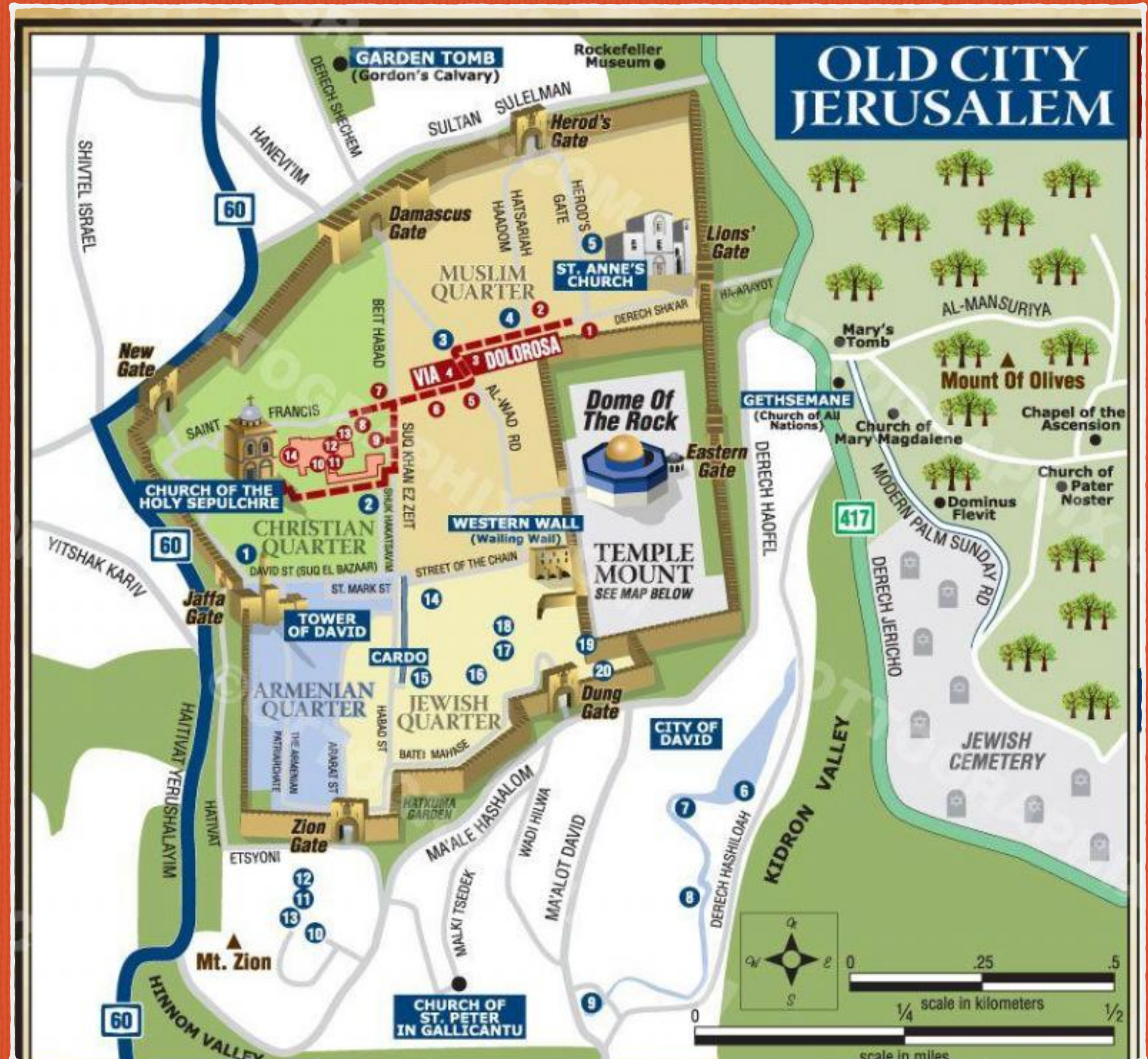

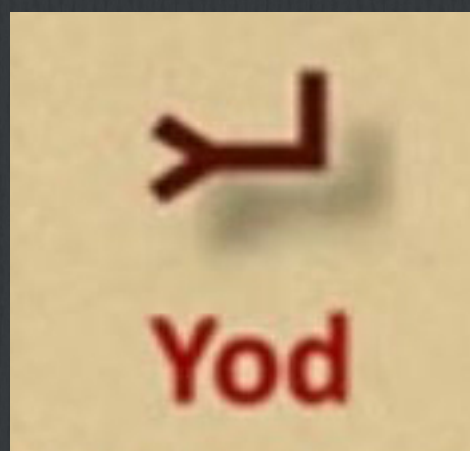

Wholly righteous person. In the context of Chabad literature, one who has conquered his animal impulses and is filled entirely with love and reverence for God. Humility, on ones side.

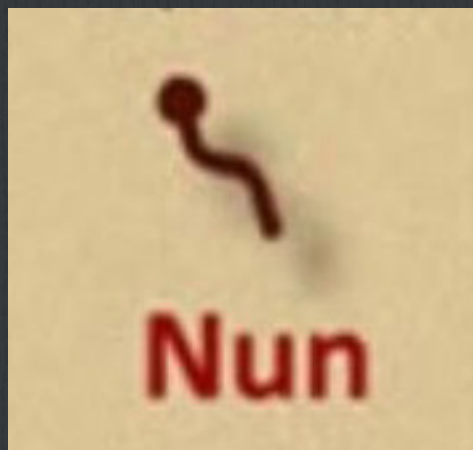


One of two regular words for hand (for the other see the 11th letter). The noun יָ (yad) denotes the hand, typically not as outstretched, but rather as holding something or being a fist. The word is synonymous with power or might; to fall in one's hands. It's typical that the alphabet's smallest letter came to mean power, but perhaps its shape reminded of a little fist. As postfix, this letter י (yod) forms a possessive, and as prefix it creates a third person singular imperfect.





The word ו (waw) means hook or peg, and is strictly reserved for the hooks/ pegs that kept the curtains of the tabernacle in place. It is said that the shape of the letter ו (waw) reminds of a hook or peg; Join, add



The verb נוּן (nun) means propagate, increase. Derivative נִין means offspring, posterity. The letter is often said to mean and resemble a fish, but the word nun is not used as such in the Bible. instead, the word for fish comes from another verb which means multiply, increase: דָּגָה (daga).







- ☐ Isa 33:5 - The LORD is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled Zion with judgment and righteousness.

Rom 9:31-33 But Israel, which followed after the law of **righteousness**, hath not attained to the law of righteousness. 9:32 Wherefore? Because they sought it not by **faith**, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone; 9:33 As it is written, Behold, I lay in **Sion** a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

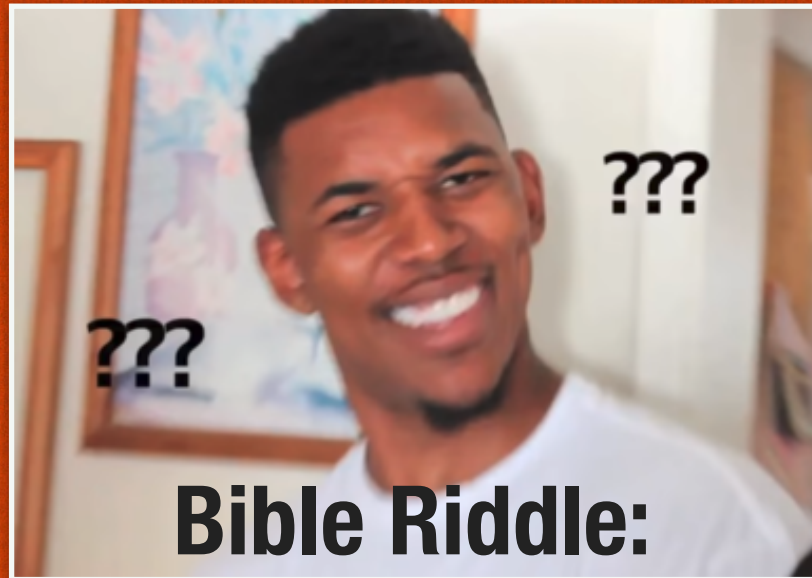
A mountain is sign that stands out but is humble! It goes through the trials and tribulations but is not easily shaken.

Why the Ark?

First 2 places the word Zion is mentioned are prophetic.

**Symbolic for the people returning to His Torah.
Where is the Ark of the Covenant
Today? Will it return during tribulation?**

☐ **1Kings 8:1 Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto king Solomon in Jerusalem, that they might bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which is Zion.**

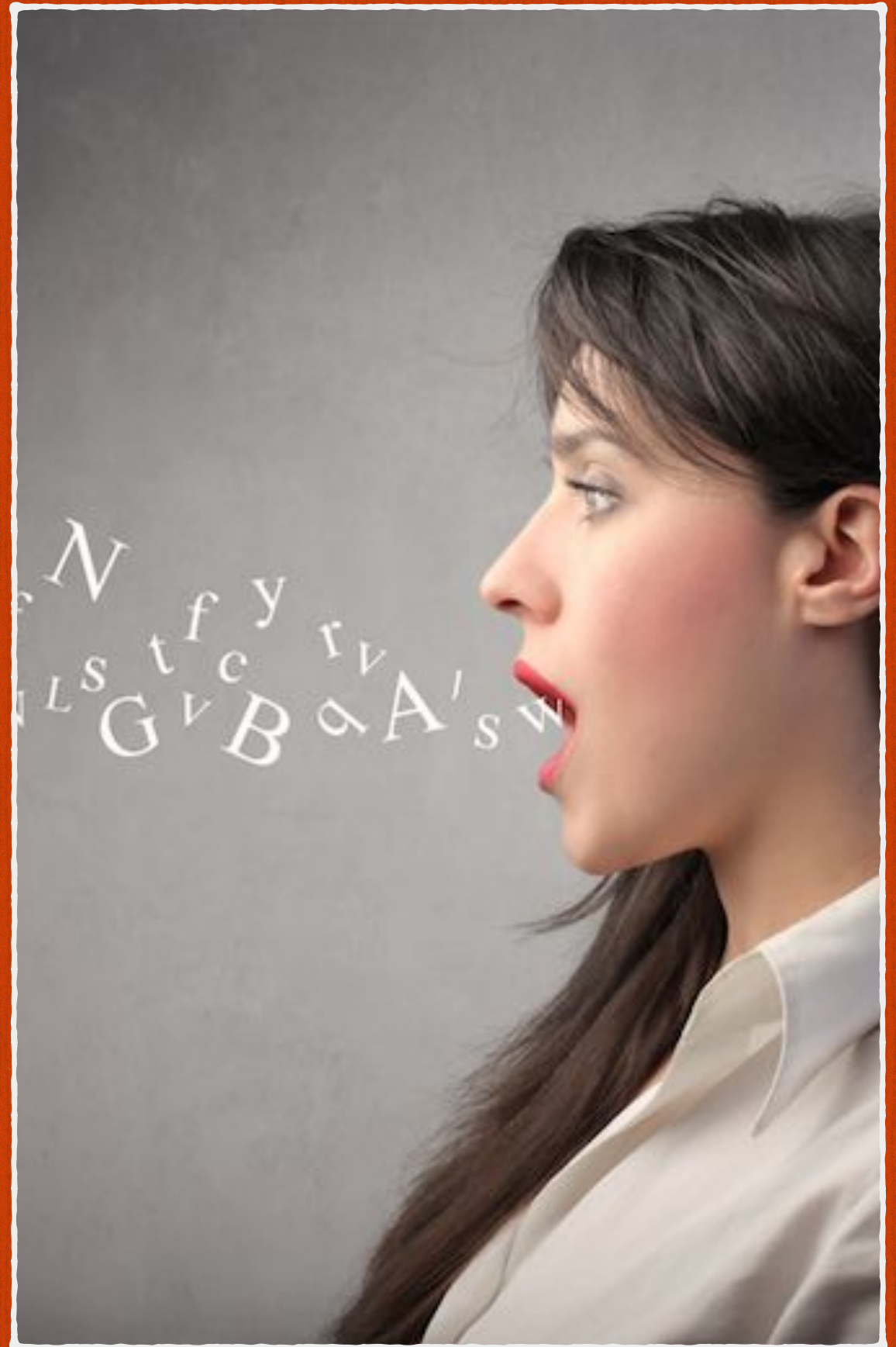
☐ **Mic 4:2 - And many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.**

The Word is in our hearts.

So Just as the physical torah goes out from the Physical Zion and shown to the nations so too must the Word of Yah go out from us as individual people and collectively. Must be lived out and spoken outwardly!

Isa 51:7 - Hearken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose heart is my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings.

Isa 51:16 - And I have put my words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow of mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou art my people.



Why is Zion not mentioned in the Torah or the other biblical books if it's so important?

- ☐ **2 Samuel 5:7** Nevertheless David captured the strong hold of Zion the same is the city of David.

Because Zion is connected to David which is a Prophetic picture of Messiach raising us up in the end days and Kingdom.

David was prophesying of Zion's Redemption.

- ☐ **Isa 52:2 - Shake thyself from the dust; arise, and sit down, O Jerusalem: loose thyself from the bands of thy neck, O captive daughter of Zion. Isa 52:3 -For thus saith the LORD, Ye have sold yourselves for nought; and ye shall be redeemed without money.**
- ☐ **Isa 51:11 - Therefore the redeemed of the LORD shall return, and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away.**
- ☐ **Psa 74:2 Remember thy congregation, which thou hast purchased of old; the rod of thine inheritance, which thou hast redeemed; this mount Zion, wherein thou hast dwelt.**



Yeshua in Zion

The Messianic Area

YHWH dwells in mount Zion.

- ☐ **Joe 3:17** So shall ye know that I am the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.
- ☐ **Zec 8:3** Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain.

Salvation and Power out of Zion

- ☐ **Isa 45:8** Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness: let the earth open, and let them bring forth salvation, and let righteousness spring up together; I the LORD have created it.
- ☐ **Isa 45:13** I have raised him up in righteousness, and I will direct all his ways: he shall build my city, and he shall let go my captives, not for price nor reward, saith the LORD of hosts

Yeshua gives power and blessings to His servants

- Hos 6:3 Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.
- Act 2:16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; 17. And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:(The oneness)
- Joe 2:23 Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month.
