Who is our Savior?

Who is the Father?

John 14:8 Philip said to Him, Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us. 9 Jesus said to him, Have I been with you such a long time and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father. And how do you say, Show us the Father? 10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father in Me? The Words that I speak to you I do not speak of Myself, but the Father who dwells in Me, He does the works.

Jesus (Yehshua in Hebrew) tells Philip that He is also the Father. He says if you have seen Me, then you have seen the Father. The Father is in Me and I am in the Father.

Isaiah 25:9 And one shall say in that day, Lo, this is our God. We have waited for Him, and He will save us. This is Jehovah; we have waited for Him, we will be glad and rejoice in His salvation.

Isaiah 43:3 For I am Jehovah your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior; I gave Egypt for your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for you.

Isaiah 43:11 I, I am Jehovah; and there is none to save besides Me.

Jehovah (Hebrew Yehovah from YHVH) clearly says He is the Savior and no other can save you.

Isaiah 43:10 You are My witnesses, says Jehovah, and My servant whom I have chosen; that you may know and believe Me, and understand that I am He. Before Me no God was formed, nor shall there be after Me.

Yehovah said NO God shall be formed before Him or after Him.

So who is Jesus? How do we reconcile this?

Isaiah 45:14 So says Jehovah ... 15 Truly You are a God who hides Yourself, O God of Israel, the Savior. 16 They shall be ashamed, and also confounded, all of them; they who are makers of idols shall go into disgrace together. 17 But Israel shall be saved in Jehovah with an everlasting salvation... 18 For so says Jehovah the Creator of the heavens, He is God, forming the earth and making it; He makes it stand, not creating it empty, but forming it to be inhabited. I am Jehovah, and there is no other. 19 I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth. I did not say to the seed of Jacob, Seek me in vain. I Jehovah speak righteousness, I declare things that are right. 20 Gather yourselves and come; draw near together, escaped ones of the nations; those who set up the wood of their graven image, and those that pray to a god that cannot save. They know nothing. 21 Declare and bring near; yea, let them take counsel together. Who has declared this of old? Who has told it from then? Is it not I, Jehovah? And there is no other God besides Me; a just God and a Savior; there is none besides Me. 22 Turn to Me, and be saved, all the ends of the earth; for I am God, and there is no other. 23 I have sworn by Myself, the word

has gone out of My mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, that to Me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.

Hosea 13:4 Yet I am Jehovah your God from the land of Egypt, and you shall know no God but Me. For there is no Savior besides Me.

Are there any New Testament scriptures that say Jehovah God, the Father is our Savior?
Yes, there is.

Luke 1:47 and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.

1 Timothy 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ according to the command of God our Savior...

1 Timothy 2:3-4 3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who will have all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

1 Timothy 4:10 For to this we both labor and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the preserver of all men, especially of those who believe.

Titus 1:3 ... entrusted by the command of God our Savior

Titus 2:10 ...so that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things.

Titus 3:4 But when the kindness and love of God our Savior toward man appeared,

Jude 1:25 "To the ONLY wise GOD our SAVIOR, be glory and majesty and might and authority, even now and forever. Amen.

Every one of these verses is a reference to the supreme deity of God the Father. Elohim is used in the original Hebrew. It is not and never has been a reference to Jesus, the son. God (Elohim) is called the Savior in both the Old Testament AND the New Testament.

Who is Our Redeemer?

What does Scripture say about this?

Psalms 19:14 Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in Your sight, O Jehovah, my Rock and my Redeemer.

Isaiah 41:14 Do not fear, worm of Jacob and men of Israel; I will help you, says Jehovah, and your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 43:14 So says Jehovah, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel ...

Isaiah 44:6 So says Jehovah, the King of Israel, and His redeemer Jehovah of Hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and besides Me there is no God.

Isaiah 44:24 So says Jehovah, your Redeemer, and He who formed you from the womb, I am Jehovah who makes all things; who stretches out the heavens alone; who spreads out the earth; who was with Me?

It is Jehovah alone who has created all things. Not Yehovah and Jesus. Not Yehovah and the Holy Spirit. You just read it with your own eyes, Yehovah is the creator and He alone is our redeemer. Here are more verses:

Isaiah 47:4 Our Redeemer, Jehovah of Hosts is His name, the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 48:17 So says Jehovah, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel, I am Jehovah your God who teaches you to profit, who leads you by the way that you should go.

Isaiah 49:7 So says Jehovah, the Redeemer of Israel, His Holy One, to Him whom man despises, to Him whom the nation hates, the servant of rulers: Kings shall see and arise, rulers also shall worship, because of Jehovah who is faithful, the Holy One of Israel, and He shall choose You.

Yehovah is our Savior and our Redeemer.

Isaiah 54:5 For your Maker is your husband; Jehovah of Hosts is His name; and your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; the God of the whole earth shall He be called.

Isaiah 54:8 In a little wrath I hid My face from you for a moment; but with everlasting kindness I will have mercy on you, says Jehovah your Redeemer.

Isaiah 59:20 And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and to those who turn from transgression in Jacob, says Jehovah.

Isaiah 60:16 You will also suck the milk of nations, and suck the breast of kings; and you will know that I Jehovah am your Savior and your Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.

Isaiah 63:16 For You are our Father, though Abraham does not know us, and Israel does not acknowledge us. You, O Jehovah, are our Father, our Redeemer; Your name is from everlasting.

Jeremiah 50:34 Their Redeemer is strong; Jehovah of Hosts, is His name. He shall thoroughly plead their cause, so that he may give rest to the land, and give trouble to the people of Babylon.

So, who is Jesus? First of all I want to clarify again that His Hebrew name is Yehshua.

The Father is the Son in the flesh. Yehovah, who is Spirit, is Yehshua, in the flesh.

Yehovah is Yehshua. They are one and the same. It was Yehovah that we hung on the tree and murdered. There are not three, as in the trinity, nor two. There is just one.

Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O, Israel. Jehovah our God is one Jehovah.

It was Yehovah who took on flesh and blood, born of a woman.
