The example shows Month 1, Year 5854;
which was year 2018 on the Gregorian
Calendar.

Month 1 in 2019 will begin when the new
moon is sighted **plus** there is enough
'Aviv' barley for the Wave Offering on the
first Sunday after Passover. The year will
then be; 5855 years since the creation
of Adam. **Both** of these events must be
confirmed by no less than two witnesses,
each in Israel.

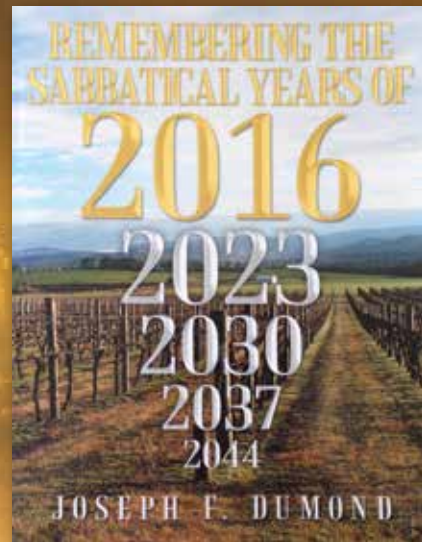
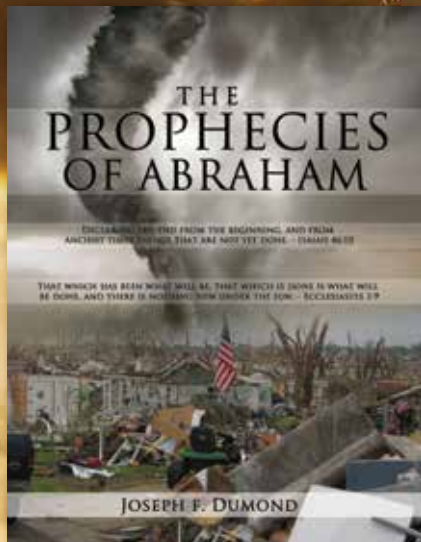
